Where it offers free mid-day meals served from 12 noon to 2.00pm.

Free breakfast, hot drinks available all day, free laundry facilities, clothing store, toilets, baths, toiletries and health care.

It can offer a lifeline to people who are homeless, in need of housing or living in poor accommodation.

It is a warm, safe, sociable place to spend the day, but also a point of contact for getting help with housing and other problems. Advice and all kinds of practical help are on offer in easy-access comfortable surroundings.

Homeless or at risk of becoming homeless and just need help

Homelessness means not having a home. Even if you have a roof over your head you can still be homeless. This is because you may not have any rights to stay where you live or your home might be unsuitable for you.

You could become homeless for many different reasons. These could include:

- being evicted by your landlord
- fleeing violence or harassment
- health problems
- relationship problems
- a disaster such as fire or flooding

If you are homeless, or worried about becoming homeless, you should get advice as early as you can. The earlier you get advice, the less likely you are to become homeless.
